Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 22.05.2018 and your letter dated 28.05.2018 furnishing required undertaking/Bank Guarantee, I am directed to convey the formal permission of the Central Government for establishment of new Medical College at Palanpur, Gujarat in the name & Style of "**Banas Medical College & Research Institute, Palanpur**" with annual intake of 150 MBBS students for the academic year 2018-19 under Section 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India and the College is recognized. The next batch of students shall be admitted only after obtaining permission of the Central Government.

3. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.

4. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K State) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the permission is granted for all India quota.

Subject: Renewal of Undergraduate Seats (MBBS) of Banas Medical College and Research Institute, Palanpur, Gujarat for the year AY- 2025-26 - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Notice dated 14-05-2025 was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

1. Seventeen (17) out of Twenty (20) departments are deficient in faculty / Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data. Anatomy, Anaesthesiology, Biochemistry, Community Medicine, Dermatology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, General Medicine, General Surgery, Microbiology, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Ophthalmology, Paediatrics, Pathology, Pharmacology, Physiology, Psychiatry, Radio-Diagnosis.

2. As per declaration uploaded : (a) No Professor available in Forensic, OBG, Ophthalmology & Psychiatry. (b) No Associate Professor in Microbiology. (c) Deficiency of Assistant Professor in

Anatomy, Biochemistry, Forensic, Pharmacology & Physiology. (d) Tutor/SR deficiency in the department of Anatomy (4)Biochemistry (03), Community Medicine (2), Surgery (SR-3), Pediatrics (SR-02), Physiology (01) and Radio-diagnosis (SR-02).
3. Cadaver deficiency of 10 (Only 10 registered in 2024 for 20.
4. No major/ minor OTs information uploaded.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:-

i. Seventeen (17) out of Twenty (20) departments are still deficient in faculty / Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.

ii. Cadaver deficiency.

4. Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, Penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

5. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report(ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory.

6. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 200 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

7. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

8. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.
